**VERY IMPORTANT** – PLACE YOUR PERMIT ON YOUR FRONT DOOR IN THE ZIPLOC BAG PROVIDED. KEEP POSTED DURING THE ENTIRE PROCESS...START TO FINAL INSPECTION! INSPECTOR WILL NEED ACCESS.

INSPECTORS WILL FAIL YOUR PROJECT WITHOUT IT!!!

Day 1 and/or 2: Excavate and Prep

Day 2 and/or 3: FORTIS will schedule a prepour inspection (if necessary). When you see a sticker, inspection report or word 'OK' spray painted on gravel....

**Day 3 thru 7:** FORTIS will pour your concrete (weather permitting) and clean your site. Framing will be removed generally by the end of the week.

Once the framing is removed, YOU will need to do your **backfill**. When your backfill has been completed, call our office at (630) 213-9540 ext:1 and your final inspection will be scheduled.

**Backfill:** After your concrete is poured, the boards used to frame your project will be removed. This will leave a gap of 6-8 inches wide between the new concrete and the grass. This gap **MUST** be filled with dirt and seed in order to prevent the base from eroding and to pass the final inspection.

**Payment:** Payment is due on the day your project is poured. (2% fee will be charged for use of credit or debit card).

**Gas/Electric Lines:** Any underground wiring or gas lines are your responsibility. Damage caused by Fortis will not affect our payout.
